

What to Pack for a Cruise

Clothes

- Sun Dresses
- Swim Cover ups
- Theme Dresses (Hawaiian, Pirate, Roaring 20's) – CWF Hosted Cruises only
- Swimsuits
- 1-2 Capri pants (women)
- 4-5 shorts
- Tank Tops/Shirts/Cruise shirts – CWF Hosted Cruises only
- Light Jacket or Sweater
- Sun Hat
- Underwear/bras/socks
- Couple of Nice Dresses or Outfits for evening chic nights

Shoes

- Flip Flops
- Tennis shoes
- Water Shoes
- Flats/Sandals
- Casual/Dress Shoes for men (for dinner)
- (optional) Heels or dress shoes for women

Personal Care

- Makeup (foundation, powder, eye makeup, etc)
- Hairbrushes
- Toothpaste/toothbrush
- Scissors/Tweezers
- Deodorant
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Hair ties
- Cotton Swabs/Qtips
- Razors
- Hairspray
- Body Lotion (although it is usually provided in the cabin)
- Blow Dryer (or curling iron or straightener as needed)
- Medications as needed
- Ibuprofen and Probiotics (not a bad idea just in case)
- Motion sickness patches
- Jewelry
- Sunscreen
- Aloe (after sun)

Miscellaneous

- Travel Documents/Driver's license/Medical Cards/Passports
- Luggage Tags (cruise)
- Excursion Tickets
- Money and/or Credit Cards
- Beach Bag or Backpack
- Small Clutch (for dinner) / Small Crossbody shoulder bag
- Small First Aid Kit
- Tablet/Computer
- Headphones
- Charging Cords (phone, computer, etc)
- Bluetooth speaker (great for at beaches or in room)
- Power Outlet/Power Strip (to get extra outlets in the room)
- Clip Fan (travel fan)
- Waterproof Case for Phone
- Beach Bag and/or Dry Bag for excursions
- Book if you like to read

I recommend a Hanging Toiletry bag. It is a huge room saver in the small bathroom in the cabin!

May want to bring Magnetic hooks that you can use to hang wet clothing or other items

Try not to pack too much

Do not take Alcohol

Do not take a Steam Iron (blow dryer is ok)

Do not bring an umbrella, there is usually one in the cabin you can use if raining at port
